Closure Measures: More than 400 checkpoints and barriers

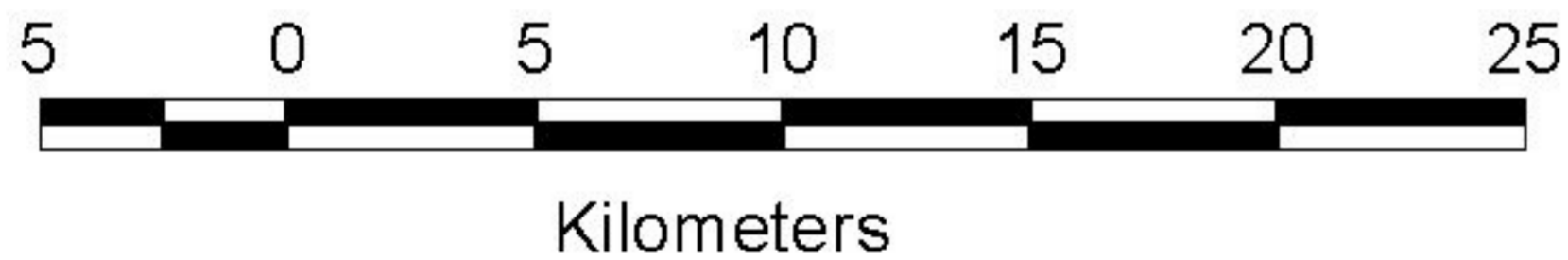
- Complete road closure
- 👤 Checkpoints manned by Israeli army
- ▲ Earth - mounds and piles of dirt used to block Palestinian roads
- ✕ Gates often manned by Israeli army to control movement between villages
- Road Block : a series of concrete blocks to prevent use of automobiles

Palestinian communities

The inhabitants of approximately 660 Palestinian communities, a population in excess of 2.5 million, are effectively imprisoned due to closure.

Israeli settlements

- Today there are more than 250 illegal settlements in the West Bank, home to approximately 300,000 settlers.
- Lands Isolated due to the Segregation Wall (phase 1)
- Lands that will be Isolated due to the Segregation Wall (phase 2)
